The Accelerated Option is for Students who have completed a Baccalaureate degree in any field and wish to obtain a Bachelor of Science in Nursing degree. The program is completed in 12 months and begins once a year (August) in Sioux Falls and once a year (January) in Aberdeen. To be considered for admissions, students must have a pre-nursing GPA* of 3.0 or higher and a cumulative GPA of 2.8 or higher. The College of Nursing also requires a major. Students are selected competitively based on experiences, attributes, and metrics. Admission criteria may include academic score, personal statements, personal references, and an interview with the admissions committee.
