The course is the last in a series (not necessarily a sequence) of four architectural history courses. In the initial roll out of the curriculum the program, the content was placed in ARCH 242 Building History II. The Department has found that the professional focus of this content is too early in student development and needs to be pushed to delivery in an advanced semester.
